

DRESS CODE

A dress code sets the standards of a welcoming environment for adults and families alike. If ever in doubt what to wear at the Club, conservative attire is recommended.

In keeping with the intended atmosphere of the Club, members and their guests are required to always wear conservative and appropriate clothing while on Club property. Persons who are not appropriately dressed will not be allowed to use the Club's facilities. Members will be held responsible for the attire of their families, privilege holders, visitors, and their respective guests. These Rules apply to all persons aged 10 and above. Since the dress code changes from time to time, it is suggested that members check with management prior to entering the Club regarding any questions about the current dress code.

Clubhouse

Casual resort attire is allowed in the dining room, on the Verandahs and Latitudes deck. No bathing suits, tee shirts, or cutoffs may be worn in the Clubhouse. Dress denim is permitted in the Clubhouse however, hats and/or visors are not permitted to be worn by gentlemen anywhere in the Clubhouse, unless as part of a formal attire during special events.

Remember if you are wearing jeans, they should be dress denim and without holes.

For evening dining in the Clubhouse, slacks, or dress shorts along with collared shirts are required for the gentlemen. Gentlemen's shirts are requested to be tucked into slacks or shorts, unless approved by Club Management as acceptable fashion. Ladies are expected to dress in a fashion compatible with the dress required of gentlemen.

Sandbar Grille

Diners at the Sandbar Grille shall abide by the same codes by wearing shirts, cover-ups, and shoes.

Fitness Room

Proper fitness attire is required: athletic or gym designed fashions. Denim of any kind, short shorts or cut-offs are not permitted. Rubber soled athletic shoes must be worn. Open toed shoes, sandals, boat shoes, or street shoes are not permitted in the workout room.

Pool / Pool Decks

Appropriate attire for the swimming pool is governed by the traditional rules of good taste and includes only apparel specifically designed for swimming. This excludes denim of any kind, cargo shorts, cut-offs, thongs, and other substitute apparel. Swimming attire is restricted to the pool and pool deck only.

When in doubt of whether attire conforms to the Club's dress code policy, please seek the advice of the Club Staff. All dress code decisions are at the discretion of Club Staff.
